This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students attaining a C standard or above in English and Mathematics
- Improve literacy and numeracy achievement of all students in the core areas of English (Reading, Writing, Spelling) and Mathematics (Number) as measured by a range of assessment tools
- Maintain the percentage of students achieving at or beyond the National Minimum Standards for Year 3 and 5 in NAPLAN Reading, Writing, Spelling and Number tasks at a level similar to the nation
- Lift the percentage of students achieving in the NAPLAN Upper 2 Bands to 'similar' when compared to 'like schools'

Our initiatives include

- Employing a Head of Department – Curriculum to take a lead role in the development of curriculum, pedagogy, assessment and reporting
- Implementing Inquiry cycles for all Year Level teams to build capacity of teaching staff and embed as an organisation routine of school wide professional learning and development
- Increasing teacher aide hours to support classroom teachers to deliver a differentiated model of targeted teaching in numeracy and literacy
- Implementing a data wall identifying D & E students in English and Maths across all year levels to inform action/support
- Implementing quality, targeted PD programs that align with the school priority area of Australian Curriculum (reading & writing)
- Providing evidence based, data driven early intervention programs to lift student achievement in the core areas of English (Reading, Writing, Spelling) and Mathematics (Number)
- Increasing support to deliver targeted teaching in literacy and numeracy as a part of the Learning Support & Enrichment program
